

When you turn to page 42 of your worksheet packet, you'll notice that most of the content is highlighted!

Capn Micke emphasized how the Captain had to 'feel ' the sea. The same intuitive connection is necessary in making money decisions that truly support our intended life.

We've all experienced how short-lived the feelings of well-being are with the financial fixes we've tried.

The example on page 42 helps to illustrate each of these 5 steps we take in our PAUSE. As you can see, facing ourselves leads to a much different destination that simply checking financial duties off our list.

Addressing the Root of our Money Suffering

- We suffer when we refuse to accept reality.
 - Most 'financial fixes' ask money to do what it can't.
 - · Make us safe.
 - · Promise us security.
 - Give us happiness.
 - Ensure our significance.
- Sitting with life's uncertainties is uncomfortable at 1st but results in much more happiness in the end.

This slide reveals why our 'financial fixes' never really satisfy. We're the richest nation in the world but do we feel safe and secure?

Does having more money mean you're absolutely secure? Do you know a wealthy person who is unhappy? Do you feel better about yourself just because you make more money?

Also keep in mind that our egos have an insatiable appetite for wanting – and money provides an easy target.

Intuition, it is said, is strengthened by intense honesty. Accepting life's uncertainties is being honest — asking money not to give us security and happiness is being honest about what it can't do.

Using Both the Calculator and the Money Mirror

- 2 tools required when dealing with money.
 - A Calculator answers the "what" of money.
 - A Mirror addresses the "why" around money.
- Example:
 - Calculate the 10 yr. return and standard deviation of a mutual fund.
 - Reflect why you are performing the analysis? Healthy due diligence or unhealthy discontent or greed?

Most of us equate money work with the calculator – just get the facts and "run the numbers". It's the "willfulness" that Chapter 3 refers to – get it done!

You have already experienced in the worksheets you've completed, how helpful money is in seeing your life...what you love, what you fear, what you long for most... But to gain this perspective you've had to practice some "willingness" to slow down and look a little deeper.

Using the calculator before the mirror can lead to financial decisions that cause more money suffering. Using both can result in genuine financial freedom.



As you stand at the Wheel of Your Life, What causes you to change your course?

Are you content with plotting your destination into the computer and heading below deck for a good night's sleep? Or

Do you realize that reaching your intended destination requires you to feel the shifting winds on your face, the pull of the currents against the rudder?

Intuition & Information – a powerful combination that will serve you well.
